Refund Policy

All requests for refunds must be in strict compliance with the deadlines below and must be made in writing by emailing the Summer Academy at <u>office@bhef.org</u>. **There are no exceptions to this policy.**

If BHEF Summer Academy cancels a course, you will receive a full refund.

If you wish to withdraw from a course, our Refund Policy is as follows:

- Requests received by May 12, 2023 will be honored for a partial refund of 50%, less a \$100.00 processing fee.
- No refund requests will be considered after May 12, 2023. No exceptions to this policy.
- There are no refunds if a student misses class for any reason, including but not limited to quarantine, illness, or vacation.

- The Middle School Bootcamp is for incoming students, grades 6-8, as of Fall 2023.
- English Language Arts Review and Math Review courses are for <u>current</u> 6-8 graders, as of Fall 2022.
- The Middle School Bootcamp is held at Beverly Hills High School (241 South Moreno Drive, Beverly Hills, CA 90212).
- The Middle School Bootcamp is open to all students in and out of the Beverly Hills Unified School District.
- Out-of-district students are required to provide the technology needed in any course (i.e. personal laptops, tablets, etc.)
- By attending in-person classes, your child will be required to follow any and all health protocols determined by the Los Angeles County Department of Health.

Class Cancellations

Courses are dependent upon enrollment numbers. Should a course not meet the minimum number of enrollees, the course may be cancelled. COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Courses are open to incoming 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students. *English Language Arts Review and Math Review <u>three-week</u> bootcamps are for current 6-8 graders, <u>as of Fall 2022.</u> Bootcamp courses are not for academic credit. (All class offerings are subject to policies and conditions.)

A Taste of Art Grades: 6-8 This bootcamp provides students with a variety of introductory art experiences. Students will experiment with a variety of materials, techniques, and processes to create two and three dimensional works of art. All of these experiences focus on developing problem solving and other higher level thinking skills as well as fostering self expression. Students will also examine a variety of works of art and artists to help them recognize and better understand the artistic cultural achievements of societies. Students will focus on the application of the Elements of Art and Principles of Design in conjunction with artistic behaviors to heighten thought and expression in their artwork. Knowledge gained from studying other artists and cultures will be applied in solving problems in art. **Instructor: Ellen Kwon (Teacher, HM).**

Bridge to Middle School Grades: 6-8 This course is designed to introduce students to the skills and techniques that will help them prepare for the rigors of middle school. Students will learn how to access digital tools such as Aeries, Google Classroom, and Google Suite (i.e. Docs, Drive, Slides, etc.), which are commonly used at BVMS and other middle schools. In addition, students will hone their organizational, time management, and note-taking skills; learn how to keep an agenda; and learn vital communication skills such as the fundamental conventions of writing, how to talk to teachers, how to self-advocate, and how to structure effective presentations.

Creative Writing Grades: 6-8 Creative Writing is an English focused camp that explores short fiction, poetry, storytelling, and polishing and revising skills. Students draft, revise, and polish fiction and poetry through writing exercises, developing familiarity with literary terms and facility with the writing process as they study elements of creative writing. Elements of fiction writing explored in this course include attention to specific detail, observation, character development, setting, plot, and point of view. Students who are already actively engaged writers and readers learn additional tools and insight into the craft of writing to help them further hone their skills and encourage their creative as well as academic growth. **Instructor: Aaron Bennahum (English/Creative Writing Teacher, BVMS).**

Intro to Culinary Arts Grades: 6-8 This one-week bootcamp is more than just mixing ingredients. Chef Rick Leece guides students through a comprehensive culinary experience including kitchen safety and sanitation, basic cooking methods, menu and meal preparation, international cuisine, and nutritional balancing. Students will work with food and learn skills and techniques such as deboning poultry, reading recipes, and food presentation. Each day will focus on different skills and styles of cooking, and everyone leaves each day with a dish prepared from scratch. Discover the art of cooking this summer!
