

The BHEF TK-5 Summer Enrichment Academy is excited to offer in-person Summer Programs! Should our program change to virtual instruction, you will be notified at that time and the Summer Academy will be conducted online using Home Learning platforms such as Seesaw, Google Classroom, and Zoom. As always, the safety of our students and staff is our top priority.

The BHEF TK-5 Summer Enrichment Academy is proud to provide a variety of Standard Skills Review, Summer Bridge and Enrichment opportunities for TK-5 students. The TK-5 program runs for <u>four weeks</u>, from <u>June 5–June 30</u>, 2023 (see course descriptions for exact dates and times). There are <u>no courses on Monday</u>, <u>June 19th</u>.

Standard Skills Review Courses are designed for students in need of remediation and continued academic intervention support. These courses are for students in English Language Arts and Mathematics. In this program, students will receive both English Language Arts and Math intervention support. The program will offer both individual and small group instruction, as well as support through online computer programs.

Summer Bridge Courses are designed for students respectively entering Transitional Kindergarten (TK), Kindergarten, First Grade or Second Grade in the Fall of 2023. These students will get a sneak preview into their upcoming grade level in an academic, creative, and exciting format.

The **Enrichment Course** is designed to give students a more specific focus in art. These students will have the opportunity to explore a current, or even identify a new, passion in a fun and imaginative way.

Program Information

- The TK-5 Summer Academy is a four-week program, from June 5– June 30, 2023, Monday–Friday. There are no courses on Monday, June 19th.
- Students should register based on their rising grade level as of Fall 2023 (except for our Standard Skills Review courses and Mural Arts Course, which students should register for based on their current grade level as of Fall 2022).
- The TK-5 Summer Academy will be held at Hawthorne Elementary (624 North Rexford Drive, Beverly Hills, CA 90210).
- The TK-5 Summer Academy is open to all residents, inside and outside of the Beverly Hills Unified School District.

Refund Policy

All requests for refunds must be in strict compliance with the deadlines below and must be made in writing by emailing the Summer Academy at office@bhef.org. There are no exceptions to this policy.

If BHEF Summer Academy cancels a course prior to the start of the program, you will receive a full refund. If you wish to withdraw from a course, our Refund Policy is as follows:

- Requests received by May 12, 2023 will be honored for a partial refund of 50%, less a \$100.00 processing fee.
- No refund requests will be considered after May 12, 2023. No exceptions to this policy.
- There are no refunds if a student misses class for any reason, including but not limited to quarantine, illness, or vacation.
- The BHEF Summer Academy does not prorate.

Cancellation Policy

Courses are dependent upon enrollment numbers. Should a course not meet the minimum number of enrollees, the course may be cancelled. STANDARD SKILLS REVIEW

Standard Skills Review K-5

Grades K-5

Students should register based on their <u>current</u> grade level as of Fall 2022.

Grade K-5 Standards Skill Review is a grade level appropriate course designed for students to review and continue grade level standards to extend the school year for English Language Arts and Math. In this program, students will review English Language Arts standards through close reading and answering questions. For math, students will do problems with the teacher and practice grade appropriate math facts and problem-solving skills. This is intended to give students a safe space to practice academic skills without being graded.

Schedule: June 5-June 30, 2023 (4 weeks). M-F. No class June 19.

SUMMER BRIDGE COURSES

Transitional Kindergarten Summer Bridge

Grade TK

This course is designed for students <u>entering</u> TK in Fall 2023.

Is your child ready for Transitional Kindergarten? Help them make this exciting transition a smooth one and enroll them in this class. This course is specifically designed for children who will be attending Transitional Kindergarten in the Fall. Students will be introduced to the ideas of a structured classroom environment full of cooperative play, stories and language, movement, and community building. It is suggested that the child is independent with toileting so if necessary, this is something to begin practicing now.

Schedule: June 12-June 30, 2023 (3 weeks). M-F. No class June 19.

Kindergarten Summer Bridge

Grade K

This course is designed for students entering Kindergarten in Fall 2023.

Is your child ready for Kindergarten cognitively, socially and behaviorally? Help them make this exciting transition a smooth one. This course is specifically designed for children who will be attending Kindergarten in the Fall. Students will be introduced to academic Kindergarten skill areas such as Reading, Writing, and Mathematics. With a focus on Kindergarten Common Core Standards, specific content areas will include: Alphabet and Number Recognition, Sorting and Classifying Objects, Patterning and Counting, Listening to and Sharing Ideas and Stories, and Socialization with their Peer Group. Activities will include: calendar, penmanship practice; reading; storytelling; poetry, rhymes and songs; show and tell; math practice and games.

First Grade Summer Bridge

Grade 1

This course is designed for students entering 1st Grade in Fall 2023.

Is your child ready for 1st Grade cognitively, socially and behaviorally? Help him or her make this exciting transition a smooth one. This course is specifically designed for children who will be entering 1st Grade in the Fall. Students will be introduced to academic Grade One skill areas such as Reading, Writing, and Mathematics. With a focus on Grade One Common Core Standards, this course will be combined with a variety of thematic-based activities through this interdisciplinary approach. Subject areas will include elements of Art, Music, Science, Physical Education, and the Cultural Arts. Students will begin to venture deep into their own imaginations and investigate innovative and creative new ideas.

The classes will include mini lessons with the teacher each day along with practice and enrichment activities. Students will learn strategies and skills that they can continue to practice throughout the summer and as they transition to the new school year. As a result, your incoming first grader will enter with the knowledge, foundational skills, and the confidence to be successful.

Second Grade Summer Bridge

Grade 2

This course is designed for students entering 2nd Grade in Fall 2023.

This class provides a great way to keep a little routine, socialization and academic practice for your child to ensure a smooth transition into Second Grade! Students will be introduced to academic Second Grade content areas such as Reading, Writing and Mathematics. Specific Language Arts content areas will include lessons that teach and reinforce phonics, fluency, grammar, spelling, vocabulary, reading comprehension, and writing processes. Specific Math content areas will include lessons that teach and reinforce understanding of place value, standard units of measurement, build fact fluency in addition and subtraction, and identify and analyze geometric shapes. ENRICHMENT COURSE

Mural Arts Grades 3-5

Students should register based on their <u>current</u> grade level as of Fall 2022.

Participants will collaborate in painting an 8' x 8' mural, which will later be installed on an outdoor wall on the playground at Horace Mann School. During this hands-on process, students will not only learn about the art and history behind mural painting, but also how to work with acrylics and how composition and movement play a role in designing murals. Participants will be honored guests at the mural unveiling ceremony in the Fall of 2023.
